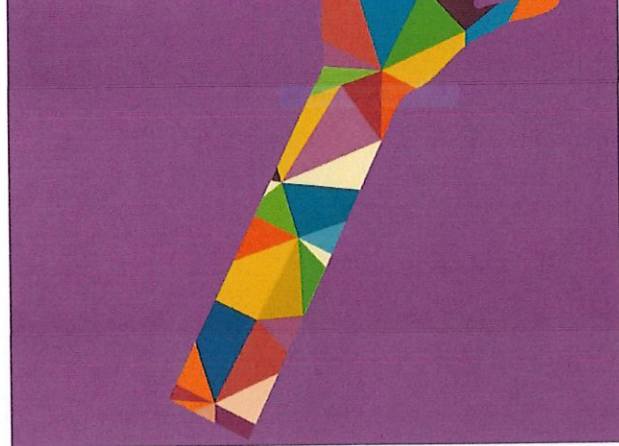

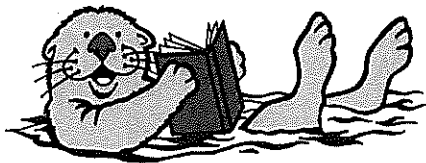

Dear 4th and 5th Grade Families,

Each year we begin looking in January to add to our existing group of students that are part of our **Elementary Chapter of the National Elementary Honor Society**. This is an organization that honors students with a 3.5 grade point average in both 4th and 5th grade and all S's in behavior. In addition, they have to be students at Oakstead for at least one semester and all eligible students in grades 4th and 5th may apply.

Many times, parents have asked what other areas are looked at when screening for this organization. In addition to the high academics and good behavior criteria, students are asked to demonstrate responsibility in the following areas according to the bylaws of the organization –

****Leadership or Leadership positions** – Elected or appointed leadership positions you have held in the school or community – i.e. captain of soccer team, class rep. for student council, director of play in the community, committee chairperson.

****Service or Service Activities** – Individual or group service projects done in or out of school. At Oakstead we do a service project monthly so there are lots of opportunities, i.e. collecting old shoes, Hats off to Cancer, Pajama Drive, Canned food drive, Diaper drive.

****Group Memberships/recognition** – Groups you belong to that you have received an award for or recognition for an accomplishment – i.e. clubs, teams, groups

****Responsibility at home or with family** – This would include activities and chores that you have done to demonstrate your responsibilities at home – i.e. household chores, care or support of relatives, taking care of pets, supervision of younger siblings.

All of these areas are looked at when the committee looks at each individual child for selection into this honor society. We hope that this will give you a better overall understanding of this group and help to guide your child for this outstanding opportunity.
